LUCERNARIUM: THE SERVICE OF LIGHT

BLESSING OF THE FIRE AND PREPARATION OF THE CANDLE

*The bishop lights and then blesses the new Easter fire. R̄. Amen.*

*The bishop takes the new candle and cuts a cross into the wax with a stylus. He traces the Greek letter alpha above the cross, and the letter omega below. He traces the numerals 2019 between the arms while he says:*

Bishop: Christ / yesterday and today /  
the Beginning and the End / Alpha / and the Omega  
All time belongs to him / and all the ages  
To him be glory and power / through every age and for ever. Amen.

*He inserts five grains of incense in the candle in the form of a cross, saying:*

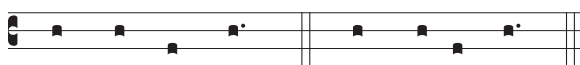
Bishop: By his holy / and glorious wounds / may Christ our Lord /  
guard us / and protect us. / Amen.

*He then lights the candle from the new fire saying:*

Bishop: May the light of Christ rising in glory  
dispel the darkness of our hearts and minds.

the flame is passed to all as he proclaims:*
